Subject:

Monotype Printing, a whimsical approach to creating art. Reverse drawing and printing without the press. Monotype is a free form of printing which leaves the artist room for experimenting with creative end results by using different papers and materials.

Artist Statement:

“All of my art is an effort to show my love for people, beauty and life itself. Originally from the Netherlands, I grew up on a farm, thus my resourcefulness from a young age.”

Education:

Hanneke attended Tilburg Katholieke Leerganen in the Netherlands, where she was taught art history, fashion, design and printmaking. She graduated with teaching degrees for both art and crafts.

She moved to the United States in 1974. In 1979, she began making monotypes, some of which were reworked into collages. Her fabric collages, paintings, watercolor and mixed media are figurative. They depict an imaginary universe with landscapes, people, still life and dreams - often inspired by real events and people.

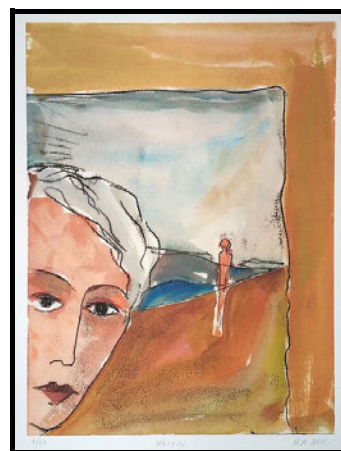

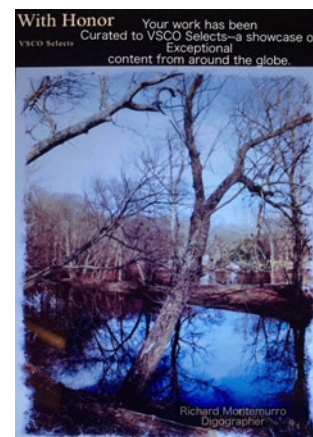

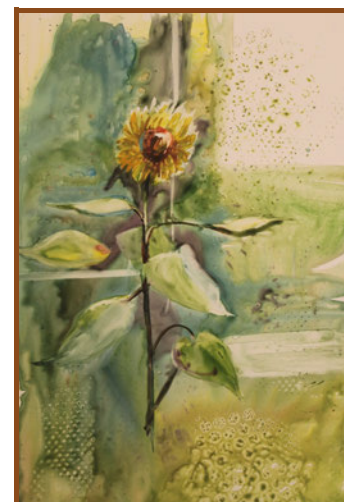

Problems with Yupo

"Yupo synthetic watercolor paper has become extremely popular for many watercolor painters. However after years of use it has been determined that, in fact it is not suitable for use with watercolor! The problem is, the vehicle in watercolor, Gum Arabic and Glycerin, do not provide a sufficient mechanical grip with the paper. Over time with expansion and contraction of both the paper and the paint, the paint begins lose its grip and flake off ruining the painting. Older paintings will begin to see a collection of paint chips and dust on the mat board. This has been long known to some and in fact the American Watercolor Society put out a directive about this subject several years ago."

"However there is good news! By simply shifting your medium to liquid acrylic you can avoid any of these problems. This issue is something that the late Nicolas Simmons and I had spoken about. Some of you may remember seeing Nick's prize winning *watercolors* in many watercolor magazines and often on the back of those same magazines where he was the spokesman for one of the Liquid Acrylic brands. Liquid acrylic is worked very much like watercolor and the adjustment for most artists is seamless. The polymer in the liquid acrylic provides an excellent mechanical grip with the paper, almost becoming part of the paper, eliminating the problem."
