Linda studied Portraiture with several artists from Studio Incaminati in Philadelphia founded by the renowned Portrait artist Nelson Shank. She worked at one of her favorite places in the world ,Walt Disney World, Drawing portraits of the guests, up to 80 a day.

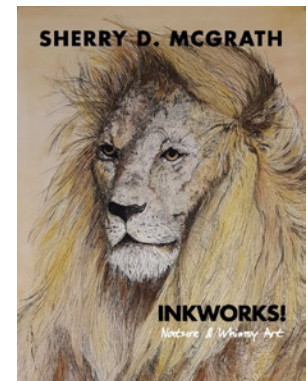
Today Linda does commission portraits in pastel or oils. She also has joined talents with another talented lady, Helen Green, who also has the love for portraiture and the Eagles.
